Frontdesk for reception, signpost with opening hours (see page 1)

Starting 2014 - 08 - 14 End 2014 - 08 - 21


PROCESS

Daily I ask one person in the drawing class to give me ten numbers between 11-122.

Number 1-10 were the first ten words in my mind and I used them on first day.

Checklist and documents

- 1. When room is controlled and notice about all gone words
- 2. Daily report with person and chosen numbers and words (see pic. below)
- 3. Daily report of remaining words (see pic. below)
- 4. Report of words found in other spaces (see pic. below)
- 5. Report of guests, visitors and temporarily users (see pic. below)




